Automatically collected data may include:

- IP address
- Browser type
- Device information

Collected via cookies and analytics tools.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use collected information to:

- Provide medical evaluation and treatment
 - Schedule appointments
 - Communicate about your care
 - Process payments
 - Verify insurance benefits
 - Improve our website and services
 - Comply with legal and regulatory requirements
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4. HIPAA & Health Information Protection

If you receive medical services from Flourish Medical Services LLC, your Protected Health Information (PHI) is handled in accordance with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

We implement administrative, physical, and technical safeguards to protect your health information.

Patients may receive a separate **Notice of Privacy Practices** outlining HIPAA-specific rights.

We do **not sell** your personal or health information.

We may share information only when necessary with:

- Laboratories or diagnostic services
- Billing and insurance companies
- Payment processors
- Legal or regulatory authorities when required

Our website may use cookies to:

- Remember preferences

You may disable cookies through your browser settings, though some features may not function properly.

We implement reasonable security measures including:

- HIPAA-compliant platforms (when applicable)
